February 11, 2019

- I. **Meeting of the Public Arts Commission call to order** held on February 11, 2019 at the Palos Heights Library 7:10p.m. motioned by John Hanley, 2nd by Lynda Schiappa. Present were Maria DeCaprio-Sunta , John Hanley and Lynda Schiappa.

- II. **Approval of Minutes**
 - a. Motion to approve January minutes by John Hanley, 2nd by Lynda Schiappa
- III. **Old Business**
 - a. Butterfly Sculpture - Mathew Placzek received his check and is starting our sculpture, he will be doing a photo documentation of the process and sharing it with Maria who will post it to our social media. The sculpture will be ready late spring early summer. We still owe \$5,000.00
 - b. Recreation Center Mural Project – This is a project that began in 2017 and is now being re-visited after getting sidetracked with other projects. This mural will be open to the public; Each 5”x 5” canvas will be purchased by an individual and is to reflect an image of what makes Palos Heights special to that person; Any medium can be used. Maria presented 3 possible promotional pieces for the project. It was decided that we would use the title “Reflections”; John will measure the wall; Vanessa will continue to develop the promotional piece for this project; Maria will order the canvas after we get our budget, a rough estimate of how many canvases we would need is approximately 150. Each canvas will be hung with Velcro so as the mural grows and we receive more entrees, adjustments and placements can be made with ease. The mural will be hung in the original discussed location on the south wall of the new entrance.
 - c. Budget Review – Lynda does not have an update at this time.
 - d. Approval of Bill – No bills.

- IV. **New Business**
 - a. A question regarding missing artwork that Shepard H.S. students created and framed last year, that were to be hung at the Rec center, needs to found. Lynda will reach out to Sharon at the Rec Center to try and locate. A separate discussion ensued of the original mural reflecting images of Palos Heights that was hung adjacent to the now “Orchard Room”, we need to locate that as well and find a location to reinstall at the Rec center.
 - b. Little Library – John will complete the restoration of the Little Library from the Art Garden, Lynda will paint our PAC logo on it and we will ask public works to reinstall in April.
